

Event Regulation

In order to guarantee the correct functioning of the event, these rules are to be considered BINDING. All of its points must be respected.

§ Historical period:

Every guest association must define at enrolment which historical period it will reenact following this format:

[Association name], historical period: [historical period].

Example: Magli d'Acciaio, historical period : late XVth century

§ Behaviour:

It is forbidden to use modern or non-period related items (cigarettes, phones etc.) on the whole event area. Specific areas - denominated as Free Zone - will be assigned for the usage of such items.

Weapons must be used ONLY on the dedicated areas.

§ Encampment:

On and around the encampment and arena grounds:

- It is forbidden the use of non-period items (cans, plastic tableware etc.)
- It is forbidden to dress in modern clothes.
- Modern sleeping bags or bedrolls must be hidden out of sight during day-time; its usage is allowed on Saturday-Sunday night between 22.00 on Saturday and 9.00 on Sunday.

- Fires can be lit in dedicated and safe fireplaces (braziers, ovens, stoves). Hay and firewood will be made available in small amounts by the organizers. If an association wants to organize its own field kitchen, the association itself must provide additional firewood.
- Each association must have a portable fire extinguisher.
- Each and all gear and equipment that can be dangerous must be safely stored such as it will not cause harm to the public
- It will not be possible to wear modern glasses during the event. The usage of historical frames is allowed. In case of serious health issues, an exemption can be made if properly communicated to the organizers by May 30th 2022.
- After 00.00 noises must be limited to a minimum.
- Staff members will be present all over the encampment and for the whole duration of the event in order to help guests. They will be easily recognizable by the modern dress with red t-shirt with the event brand and by a badge.

§ Arrival time:

- Guests must arrive by Friday evening to set up camp.
- Guests must guarantee their attendance for the whole event. Issues on attendance must be immediately communicated to the organizers.

§ Meals:

It is allowed to set up a field kitchen and to eat in the encampment, as long as the historically accurate gear is used:

- Wooden, brass, ceramic or pewter plates and cups
- Glass glasses or ceramic or pewter mugs (no horns)
- Silverware.

The Staff will deliver meals to the guest association president or their delegate. Meal distribution times will be notified at the welcome meeting.

Saturday evening there will be a banquet, where all guests will be asked to dress in an historical dress of appropriate rank.
