



## CAMP REGULATION

These regulations are **binding for** participation in the event. Every point of it must be complied with.

We rely on the good sense of the participants in the event, who by their adhesion subscribe their full assent to the following regulations, remembering that the ultimate aim of the SILVER LION TOURNAMENT is mainly to live together a beautiful day of competition and historical re-enactment, but secondarily there is also the task of introducing the general public to the various aspects of the daily life of a medieval armiger. It will therefore be up to you to manage your corner of the field and, if necessary, to illustrate to the spectators the various aspects of daily life at the time.

### Historical period:

Each association must present the reference period at the time of registration, for example:

- Association 'X', historical period evoked: second half of the 14th century).

### Rules of conduct:

Any behaviour involving the use of an anachronistic object (use of a mobile phone, smoking a cigarette, etc.....) is strictly forbidden in the camp as well as in the other places involved in the event. Suitable areas will be provided.

It is compulsory to perform or train with any kind of weapon **ONLY** within the camp.



## Camp:

In areas used for 'Historical Re-enactment' (encampment and lizza), associations or individuals must observe the following elementary rules:

1. The use of equipment and/or structures made of anachronistic material is generally prohibited.
2. It is forbidden to wear modern clothing in a partial manner.
3. It is forbidden in the camp to use modern and similar objects (such as drinking from cans or plastic cups) even if purchased locally. Bringing objects in plastic bags also falls into this category.
4. Modern overnight equipment must be concealed during the day, may only be placed after 11 p.m. on Saturday and must be concealed again by 9 a.m. the following morning.
5. It is possible to light a fire, as long as you use a brazier or a hearth.
6. Each Association must be equipped with a portable fire extinguisher.
7. Wood will be made available, but it is limited. It is advisable for those who wish to cook to bring an extra quantity.
8. All material that may pose a danger to the public and to participants in the event itself must be placed in a safe position in order to protect people's safety.
9. **It will not be possible to wear spectacles in any area\*** used for the "Rievocazione Storica" during the event hours. It is possible to use historical spectacles according to the period re-enacted by the group itself (**\*in case of serious problems please contact the organisation in advance, by 31 March 2023**).
10. At 00.00, IN RESPECT OF THOSE WHO WANT TO SLEEP, noise should be limited as much as possible.
11. During the entire period of the event, there will be, at the Sala d'Arme 'I Magli d'Acciaio' camp, contact persons wearing red T-shirts and badges who will help the associations in case of questions or doubts.



## Arrival Time

- Each association must set up its camp by 21:00 on Friday 30 June.
- Guests must guarantee representation until the end of the event.
- Any delays or other problems must be reported to the organisation in good time.

## Free zone

In the encampment area as displayed, the use of anachronistic objects such as smoking or telephoning is prohibited. For such tasks, you may go to the easily identifiable 'out-of-camp' areas (dining area, stage area).

## Meals

Lunch, dinner and breakfast will be eaten together in the communal velarium.

On Saturday evening, a banquet will be held to celebrate the feats of arms performed during the Tournament. Guests are invited to wear dress appropriate to their rank to make the most of this moment of feasting and sharing.
